None of our efforts will ever raise us up to God's level. We can't earn God's gift of salvation, or buy it, or even deserve it. We can only accept it as the free and generous gift of a loving and forgiving God. "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)
